

SASKATCHEWAN TARGET SHOOTING ASSOCIATION CODE OF CONDUCT

It is not the Saskatchewan Target Shooting Association’s (STSA) policy to dictate an athlete’s general lifestyle. However, rules of conduct while at competitions or training events are necessary for legal and physiological reasons, as well as for the good of the program. Your selection to our team indicates that problems are expected to be minimal.

1. Athlete Statement
I am a high performance athlete and as such realize that I can set a positive example for my peers. I will at all times behave in a manner which will bring a positive reflection of myself to, my society, sport, fellow athletes and province, whom I represent.
2. Alcohol – Athletes of legal drinking age are expected to be responsible users of alcohol. Drunkenness or the provision of alcohol to minors will not be tolerated at any time. The use of alcoholic beverages in any quantity within 24 hours prior to shooting is not permitted. Junior team members are prohibited from consuming alcohol while on team outings.
3. Drugs – Abuse of drugs, including alcohol, may result in life suspension from the provincial team. All Saskatchewan Handgun Association athletes are governed by the Banned and Restricted Doping Classes and Methods list distributed by the Canadian Centre for Drug-Free Sport.
4. Curfews – Quiet time for all junior team members, when they must be in their rooms, is 2230. Lights out 2300 (11:00 p.m.). The only exception is when accompanied by a chaperon.
5. On Time – All athletes will arrive at the times requested by their coaches.

The severity of disciplinary measures for rules infractions will depend on the circumstances and infraction.

Athletes may be sent home for rules infractions. If this happens, parents will be notified of travel arrangements. It is the sincere hope of the STSA that these measures will not be necessary. Athletes sent home for disciplinary reasons may be required to pay for the added expense of changed travel arrangements.
